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### Changes Ahead

The school and the Church have been in negotiations with the residents of Ablea Green over the access to the school from the Church side. ### Paying Fees

Rani has been very busy in the office this week getting the data prepared to send out invoices. They will probably be with you this week. Please let us know if you would like a payment plan.

Please enquire with your employer if they run a voucher scheme - this is a tax efficient way of paying for your child's preschool education and afterschool care when they get older.

I would ask you to look into it now (if you have not already done so) because the scheme's will be closing to new entrants very soon.

### Paying by Voucher Scheme

The voucher providers have asked that we make you aware that the schemes are closing to new entrants. If you are already in a scheme you do not need to worry but if you are not in a scheme or did not know about it time is running out to join. Rani, Viv and Louise can explain some or follow the link for the official information <https://www.employersforchildcare.org/campaign/giving-parents-a-choice-of-childcare-support/> or if you know you would like the schemes to remain open while you investigate you can join the campaign by doing the following:

**Contact your local MP:** Ask them to sign the Early-Day Motion and put pressure on the government to keep Childcare Vouchers - it's free, easy to do, and takes less than five minutes. Just visit [www.theyworkforyou.com](http://www.theyworkforyou.com), enter your postcode to find out who represents you, and click on the green "Send a message" button to contact them.

Share this campaign with your networks: Encourage parents who use your services as well as staff and colleagues to write to their MP. As the deadline to join the scheme approaches, they may lose out unless the government keeps it open.

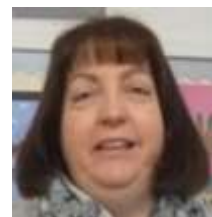

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Each Week there will be a plan on this page. It details the areas of learning that we are looking to observe and promote.

It also details the toys that we put out at the beginning of the session. Of course this does change during the session as the children play we do swap things around.

The Early years Foundation Stage Framework is our legal guidance. It states:

*"There are seven areas of learning and development that must shape educational programmes in early years settings. All areas of learning and development are important and inter-connected.*

*Each area of learning and development must be implemented through planned, purposeful play and through a mix of adult-led and child-initiated activity. Play is essential for children's development, building their confidence as they learn to explore, to think about problems, and relate to others. Children learn by leading their own play, and by taking part in play which is guided by adults."*

During the academic year I will write some information on the seven areas of learning which will help you to understand what we do but PLEASE ask any one of the team if you want extra clarification.

We do like your suggestions too. If your child is really interested in something at home let us know.

There is no plan this week as we just want to get the children settled.
