Car Parking

I have heard from the school today that from October 15 there will be no vehicular or pedestrian access from the Church side. Your only access will be from the Rosebank.

This is a very difficult situation for us all, please be understanding of the school and Nursery staff who need to be parked in the car park before session starts. If you are having problems please let me know, I would like to help but I do not have any solutions.

Below is how the parents at the school have been told. I hope Mrs Kenefick does not mind me using her words!

"Over the past few years, school Governors, the Parish Team and Diocese have collectively tried to avert this action through extensive negotiation and communication with the Directors of the Abelea Green Management Company (Epsom) Ltd. However, the Directors have made their position very clear in their expectation that access should cease.

To be clear, Abelea Green Management Company (Epsom) Ltd (AGMC) are correct in their assertion that there is no documentary right of access through this route. Through negotiation, we had hoped to reach a point whereby access was permitted but this was not agreed by AGMC. Therefore, the Diocese have been left with no choice but to impose closure.

As parishioners, we retain the right to access our church from Rosebank and so the gate will be opened by the parish for all mass times."

Thank You Megan for helping out this week we hope that we will see more of you.

We always welcome you as a volunteer, if you would like to come and play please let me know.
